- 1. New Forest Association (NFA) objects to this application.
- 2. This is simply an application to breach the cornerstone policy of the National Park, CP12 that restricts new dwellings to the defined villages. Applications seeking to breach that policy regularly occur, are always refused and the Authority is invariably supported at appeal. Application 00580 is the most recent to be refused at Committee.
